

The gateway test
Math 31, Spring 2007

This semester, you will be given a “gateway test” on integration. The quiz consists of 7 functions for you to integrate (both definite and indefinite), and affects your overall grade in the following way.

- The gateway counts for two normal quiz grades.
- You may not use any books, notes, or calculators on the gateway.
- Initially, both quiz grades will be based on the score you get the first time you take the gateway, on **Thu Mar 01**.
- After Thu Mar 01, you may take the gateway as many times as you like; it will be administered one more time in class, in **Mon Mar 05**. Until the 2nd midterm (**Thu Mar 15**), both of your gateway grades will be raised to match the highest score you have ever earned. After the 2nd midterm but before the 3rd midterm (**Thu Apr 19**), your second gateway quiz grade will be raised to match the highest score you have ever earned, but the first grade will no longer change.
- If you do not get at least 6/7 on the gateway test before the 3rd midterm, your final semester grade will be lowered by one “notch”, e.g., A to A⁻, B⁻ to C⁺, etc., and you will no longer be able to retake the gateway.
- After Mon Mar 05, you may only take the gateway during my office hours: M 1:30–4pm, W 1:30–3pm, Th 3:30–4pm, MacQuarrie Hall 419, and Thu noon–1pm, MacQuarrie Hall 233. (Office hours may occasionally be rescheduled, but you will usually be notified before this happens.)
